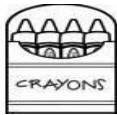

Women of Hope Conference – “A Light of Hope,” Feb 6-7, in Murfreesboro, TN.

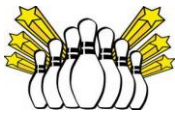
Registration can still be done at www.hhi.org. There is space in the rooms already reserved. Please see Nancy Posey if you want to join in and go.
