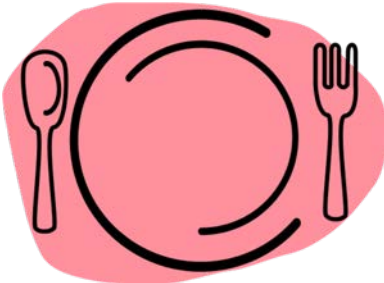

Lucas Mabie, 16, Bentonville, AR, Hazel Howard's nephew, has leukemia. He fought it when four; in remission 12 years.

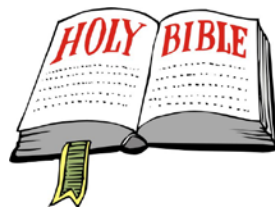
Missy Stroud is recovering from shoulder surgery.
