Pray for the Holy Spirit's direction of the elder selection process at HCOC Congregation Leadership to come together for the good of all.

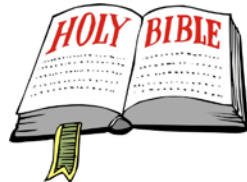
