ILO - REPORT

Dear brethren in Christ,

Greetings from the church of Christ in ILO.

I came to work for the Lord to ILO – Peru four years ago. This has been a wonderful experience and I want to continue serving the Lord.

In October of last year my wife was very sick with pneumonia. She was alone in our home in Arica – Chile (about 3 hours from ILO). I felt very bad because I couldn't help her sooner. This situation made me think in returning to Arica. Veronica my wife works in Arica and she goes to ILO when she can, but her health is declining and spends more time at home now. She also has diabetes and she takes care of his elderly father (brother David) when he is in Arica. Brother Pedro said that he will be looking for an evangelist to replace me. I will continue working for the Lord in ILO until that person arrives.
