John Stasny had emergency Gall Bladder surgery

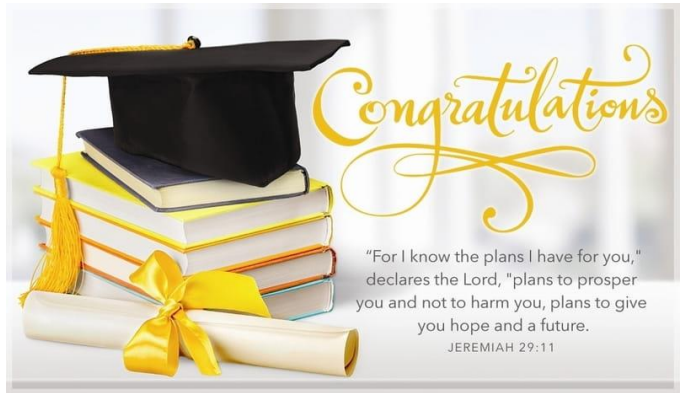
Valerie Keyes Streeter needs strength for daily challenges and as she strives to draw closer to God.
